



New Police Powers and Coronavirus Law



To stop the spread of coronavirus there are **new rules** we all have to follow

The rules say there are only 4 things you should go outside for



You can go out to buy food and medicine



You can go out to get medical help



You can go out to exercise once a day



You can travel to work if you are a key worker



The law says you can also be outside if you are in danger of being **hurt at home** or of getting ill or injured



The Police can **stop** you to ask why you are outside



The Police can **tell you to go home** if you are not meant to be outside



The Police can **take you home** if you do not go home when they tell you to



The police can **fine you** if you break the rules about being outside

This means you will have to pay money



The first fine is £60 if you pay it within 14 days you will only have to pay £30



You can be **fined each time** you break the rules You will have to pay more money each time up to £960



The police **cannot arrest you** just for being outside

They can talk to you or call someone who supports you



If you **spit or swear** at the police or try to **hit or kick** them they **can arrest you** even if you are meant to be outside



Stay home as much you can to keep **safe and** well
