

Job Title: Sessional Activity Lead

The Role: We are currently seeking dynamic and self-motivated individuals to work within this team based out of Kentish Town and across the Camden Borough.

Ideal candidates will support adults to access the wider community and use their teaching and coaching skills to deliver sessions across the programme such as (but not limited to) physical activities, computers, sensory, relaxation, music, arts and/or drama.

As the programme is user lead, our activities and shift times are varied from daytimes, late afternoons and early evenings during the week and then daytimes at the weekends

Responsibilities:

- Plan, deliver and facilitate group sessions which embed and develop individual skills
- Empower and motivate individuals through sessions to identify their needs, set goals and support them to achieve their objectives.
- Monitoring each session and reporting back to the project manager; including capturing accurate data securely on individuals attending the sessions
- Work effectively with the staff team, partnered professionals and stakeholders to coordinating onward pathways for individuals, as well as meeting objectives of the project
