Travel **Exercise** You must stay at home and You can leave your home only travel for legally permitted to exercise alone, with your reasons such as to go to work. You must not leave a tier 4 area. Outdoor sport allowed, Residents in tiers 1-3 must not travel into a tier 4 area. Travel for youth and disabled sport. abroad is not allowed, unless an exemption applies. Accommodation vulnerable People who are clinically extremely vulnerable are advised to stay at home, Closed, with limited exceptions. healthcare appointments.

Personal care Closed. Residential care Visits allowed with COVIDsecure arrangements such household or support bubble. as screens, visiting pods and window visits. gathering limit applies except **Clinically extremely** Worship 饿ѷৠ ᢗ᠓ᡮ Open, but you cannot interact with anyone outside except for exercise or to attend household or support bubble.

Overnight stays



You must not stay away from home. Limited exceptions apply.

Work from home quidance



Everyone must work from home unless they are unable to do so.

Entertainment and tourist attractions



Indoor venues closed. Some outdoor attractions may remain open.

Education



Nurseries, schools, colleges and universities open. Supervised activities. childcare and childcare bubbles allowed.

Bars, pubs and restaurants



Closed, but allowed to open for takeaway, delivery and drive-through.
