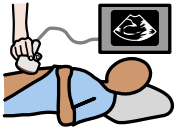
# Tests for testicular cancer



tests

Your GP may refer you for further testing after your doctors appointment. This normally happens within 2 weeks.

Some of the tests you may have are described below.



ultrasound

## Scrotal ultrasound

A scrotal ultrasound scan is where a picture is taken of the inside of your testicle.



blood tests

## Blood Tests

You may need to have some blood tests.



CT scan

## CT Scan

A pelvic CT scan can be used to confirm what stage the cancer is in and to see if the cancer has spread.
