What happens next...



Ashley has been to the doctor because their breast tissue felt different.




The doctor did an examination and has sent Ashley to have a **breast ultrasound**.



Ashley will have to visit the hospital, or a clinic to have their breast ultrasound.



They can take someone with them so they feel supported.



Ashley will be able to eat and drink normally before they have their breast ultrasound.



Ashley's appointment will be between 15 to 30 minutes, but not all this time will be spent doing the breast ultrasound.



Some of the appointment will be spent making sure
Ashley understands what will happen and making them



Ashley will need to take off the clothes above their waist but they can put a hospital gown on.



The person doing Ashley's breast ultrasound is called a sonographer.



lie down

The sonographer will need Ashley to lie down on an examination couch to do the breast ultrasound.



In the examination room there will be a computer and screen but this is nothing for Ashley to worry about, this just helps the sonographer to do their job.



The sonographer will use a wand-like machine and move it over Ashley's breast tissue.

machine



The sonographer will put a gel-like liquid on Ashley's breast tissue which can feel cold.



The gel will help the sonographer move the wand over Ashley's breast tissue easily.



The sonographer might ask Ashley to move their arm up and down while they are doing the breast ultrasound.



Ashley should not feel any pain during the breast ultrasound but the cold gel might be a little bit uncomfortable.



Once the sonographer has completed the breast ultrasound, they will give Ashley some tissue to wipe off any gel.



Ashley can get dressed after the sonographer has completed the breast ultrasound.



Ashley can go home once the breast ultrasound is finished.



The results of the breast ultrasound will be sent to the doctor who will contact Ashley to talk about **what** happens next.
