
Know Your Body: Testing for testicular cancer









Tests for testicular cancer

Your doctor may refer you for further testing after your doctors appointment. This normally happens within 2 weeks.

Some of the tests you may have are described below.



ultrasound

Scrotal ultrasound

A scrotal ultrasound scan is where a picture is taken of the inside of your testicle.



Blood Tests

Rarely, the doctor may ask for you to have some blood tests.

CT Scan



CT scan

A pelvic CT scan can be used to confirm what stage the cancer is in and to see if the cancer has spread.
